Trim Castle

[Trim Castle](#) is Ireland's largest and best-preserved Anglo-Norman castle. Built in the late 12th century by Hugh de Lacy, its massive stone keep, curtain walls, and towers offer a striking glimpse into medieval power and design. A guided tour brings the castle's history to life, leading visitors through the impressive keep, great hall, and battlements. The tour also offers panoramic views over Trim town and the surrounding countryside.



Trim Medieval Armoury

Trim Medieval Armoury offers a fascinating glimpse into the weapons and defences of the Middle Ages in Trim. Located next door to Trim Castle, the collection showcases authentic medieval arms, armour, and replicas, with expert guides explaining how they were used in battle and daily life.
